How Florida Amateur Radio Operators Gets Deployed

- Federal
 - Directly through their Served Agency i.e. Red Cross, Salvation Army, Etc.
 - Mission Requested by a State and Coordinated via Florida DEM
 - Emergency Management Assistance Compact
- State of Florida
 - Florida Counties Emergency Management Request and or State authorized NGO with MOU
 - Emergency Management Assistance Compact
- Served Agency
 - Direct support of the served agency request or directive
