AMATEUR RADIO PARITY ACT DIES IN THE U.S. SENATE. BILL TO BE REFILLED IN THE 115TH CONGRESS IN JANUARY.



Update 12/09/16: The Amateur Radio Parity Act of 2015 died in the U.S Senate on December 9, 2016 primarily due to the opposition of one U.S. Senator: Senator Bill Nelson, one of own Senators from Florida. The legislation will be reintroduced in both houses of Congress after the 115th Session begins in January. <u>act-in-the-115th-congress</u>. The ARRL has already been in contact with the sponsors of the bill to allow for an early introduction, which will give more time to obtain success.

The Amateur Radio Parity Act would have required the FCC to amend its Part 97 Amateur Service rules to apply the three-part test of the <u>PRB-1</u> federal preemption policy to include homeowners association regulations and deed restrictions, often referred to as 'covenants, conditions, and restrictions' (CC&Rs). At present, PRB-1 only applies to state and local zoning laws and ordinances. The FCC has been reluctant to extend the same legal protections to include private land-use agreements without direction from Congress."
